

How to create a company?

- Choose the name of the company
- Gather the necessary documents to register your business.
- Preparing the Memorandum and Articles of Association
- Register with the House Company (£13-£40)
- Wait for your company's validation
- Conduct the first shareholder meeting
- Establish and maintain company records
- Open a bank account
- Sign the share distribution certificate
- Register to HMRC
- Record and establish PAY (Pay as you earn) for employees.
- Consider the option of having your name or brand registered.
